GRYEH : 1970.269	shelf	Small wooden shelf decorated by chip-carving	
GRYEH : 1970.274.1	knife	One of 2 kitchen knives, chip carving knife	
GRYEH : 1970.274.2	knife	One of 2 kitchen knives, chip carving knife	
GRYEH : 1970.359	brush	Stippling brush circa 1940-50 used to make patterns in wet distemper on walls and ceilings	
GRYEH : 1971.169	screw	Iron screw from the yard of an old building firm in Gorleston	
GRYEH : 1972.35	spanner	Adjustable spanner

GRYEH : 1972.216	dish	Heated meat dish, pottery, dish set into a tin tray for holding hot water to keep meat warm on the plate, two handles and a filling spout	
GRYEH : 1974.191	till	Patent check till; mahogany box with hinged top and single drawer with 4 coin compartments, a brass drawer release works the till roll mechanism, brass maker's plate with inscription; patent check till, patent no 2153 dated June 12th 1875, E. Lofts patentee Cambridge no 171, said to have been used by donor's grandfather in his shop at Martham	
GRYEH : 1974.196	iron	Flat iron; made of solid cast iron, made by Smith, probably 1880-1939	
GRYEH : 1974.273	chair	Child's high chair; mahogany, consisting of a child's wooden armchair with overhanging top rail, rope twist back rail and leather upholstered seat, mounted on a platform with four sable shaped legs, the two separate parts are held together by a single thumb screw passing through the centre stretcher of the chair, when separated they serve as a low chair and table, circa 1840	
GRYEH : 1975.102	cabinet	Hanging corner cabinet, polished mahogany with glazed door and three shelves

GRYEH : 1977.244	mangle	The Joy Maid folding mangle; mottled grey enamelled cast iron frame with iron wheels and wooden top board, rollers and draining tray, the top half folds down inside the frame and can be replaced by a hinged wooden worktop, trade mark, the Crown, patent no 348109	
GRYEH : 1977.245	scales	Spring kitchen scales, Hughes family scale no 48, black tin casing with iron pointer and white dial graded to 20 lbs in 1 oz divisions, dial bears Salter trade mark, brass adjusting nut at top and a tin pan	
GRYEH : 1977.247.2	heater	One of two paraffin heaters; pale gold coloured metal casing and separate copper fuel container and brass burner with wick adjusting knob bearing the name Orac, transfer label on back; Taylors Para-fin Oil and Gas Appliances Ltd.. London	
GRYEH : 1978.63	washboard	Washboard; ribbed wooden slats within a wooden frame, sides of frame extended to form two legs

GRYEH : 1980.49.1	cupboard	Locally made furniture, indenture etc; a wardrobe with front and sides of panelled mahogany topped by a detachable cornice of ogee moulding with dentils beneath, central door with long bevelled mirror with curved top, stand on base with single drawer, the two brass loop handles matching that on the door; there is also a matching dressing table, both were made by Mr Leonard Archibald Darnell in the early 1920's and used by him until his death in 1980, both were collected with other items from his bungalow in Bradwell, Great Yarmouth	
GRYEH : 1980.49.2	table	Locally made furniture, indenture etc; a dressing table of polished mahogany matching the wardrobe, stands on four legs with one large and two small drawers, above the carcass are two small trinket drawers flanked by two small shelves, all drawers have matching brass loop handles, mahogany framed bevelled swivel mirror with curved top and two hinged side mirrors supported by two uprights each having at the top a carved flower design, both were made by Mr Leonard Archibald Darnell in the early 1920's and used by him until his death in 1980, both were collected with other items from his bungalow in Bradwell, Great Yarmouth	
GRYEH : 1981.87	commode	Cabinet commode; polished mahogany cabinet standing on four short turned legs, black stringing around edges of top, doors and false drawer fronts, upper half has a hinged top and two doors at front which open inwards to reveal a toilet seat and a white glazed earthenware pot with wire carrying handle suspended in lower half of cabinet, front of lower half disguised by two false drawer fronts each with a pair of turned wood knobs and a brass keyhole liner, circa 1840?, some wormholes especially around bottom front; from a collection of items bequeathed by Miss L.S. Chapman

GRIEH : 1982.68	projector	Combined Epidiascope and slide projector, rectangular black metal case with four inch diameter lens unit for epidiascope at the front, below is mounted a three inch square metal slide changed with mountings for lens unit, projector lens and condensers are missing, inside the case is an electric lampholder, one of a pair of side mirrors and a glass panel in the base, on each side are hinged doors and below one of these is a swivelling rod, the whole can be lifted by a pair of wooden handles with metal mounts fixed towards the top, made by Ross, London; found in the basement of Styles School during the last term before its closure in July 1982	
GRIEH : 1982.69	meter	Multicellular voltmeter; early electrical instrument in lacquered brass box with iron mount fixed to a wooden panel, glazed front of instrument reveals a pointer and curved scale graduated from 0 to 300, cylindrical brass extensions project above and below main body of instrument, the larger top projection has an oval brass plate screwed to the front with the inscription; Lord Kelvin's Patent / Multicellular / Voltmeter N 1605 / James White / Glasgow and London	
GRIEH : 1982.90	drill stand	Bench drill and stand; hand operated bench drill by Metabo; mounted vertically on an iron stand with round iron post; horizontal flywheel on top painted red, drill and stand painted black, the height of the drill on stand adjustable by means of a locking screw; collected from woodwork shop of Greenacre Secondary School on the last day of term before its closure

GRYEH : 1982.94	heater	Electric bed heater; shaped like a rubber hot water bottle but made from moulded brown bakelite in two halves which bolt together and contain a heating element, length of brown flex enters heater at neck, manufactured by R.A. Rothermel Limited, British Patent number 561789; bought by the donor at Bric a Brac shop in Englands Lane, Gorleston	
GRYEH : 1983.103	cage	Bird cage; rectangular cage of sheet brass and brass wire with domed top capped with a finial and carrying ring, sand tray in base and patterned ruby coloured glass slotted in around lower portion (some glass panels missing)	
GRYEH : 1984.9.1	television	Pye contemporary television, model C17, 15 inch screen in lightwood cabinet, circa 1956, said by the donor to have been given the Design Council's Design of the Year Award 1956 for its Robin Day cabinet.	
GRYEH : 1984.59	washtub	washtub, electric wash boiler; galvanised iron bucket-shaped tub on three legs, with a domed lid, two carrying handles near top and a brass tap at bottom; base incorporates an electric heating element; a slatted wooden stand rests on a rim above the element and supports a free standing galvanised iron water circulator; tub wired to an electrical flex with round-pin bakelite plug; made by Swan, probably 1920-1939

GRYEH : 1984.64	television	Philips black and white television set, type 1757 U number M 6293 in polished dark wood cabinet on casters with doors closing over screen and loudspeaker grill at front	
GRYEH : 1985.31	oven	Oven; hob top or portable oven, galvanized metal box with two wire carrying handles at the top; hinged drop-down front and two wire shelves, circular hole in base with raised platform above for use over a gas ring or spirit stove; made by Kubex, probably 1920-1959	
GRYEH : 1986.69.2	heater	Electric boiling plate; round metal electric heater with iron top, walls mottled black and white enamel, standing on iron base with three short feet, white porcelain switch turns through 360 degrees to four positions; off / high / med / low	
GRYEH : 1987.12.1	radio	Radio set; Murphy AC mains receiver type A12, serial number 406503 in polished wood cabinet with speaker grill in upper half, tuning dial and controls in lower half, circa 1954	
GRYEH : 1988.59	toaster	Sandwich toaster, General Electric Hotpoint sandwich toaster; rectangular plated metal casing in two halves, hinged at back, mounted on a rectangular metal plate with wooden handles; electrical flex plugs into side of toaster; made by General Electric, Toronto, Canada, probably 1930-1939

GRYEH : 1989.43	washboard	washboard; reeded glass panel within a wooden rectangular frame, the sides of which are extended to form two legs, back and front cushioned by rubber block	
GRYEH : 1990.60.1	washtub	washtub; round galvanised metal tub with ribbed wall and inward facing rim embossed with the words Non-Splash and Soap; probably made 1900-1949	
GRYEH : 1991.57	stove	Radiation gas cooker, grey enamel sides with white enamel door
